

### **Health Statement**

#### Updated 3rd Nov 2022

Government mandated public COVID-19 safety measures have lifted. However, as part of our commitment to providing a safe working environment for all, and as a private premises, it remains a condition of your access to The Brighton Studio for all staff, visitors, clients and their guests to agree to, read and understand following statements. And; to agree to follow the guidelines on Page 2 completely.

- You have no cause to believe that you have COVID-19
- As far as you are aware, you have not been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or anyone who is showing symptoms consistent with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- You have not traveled to, nor to your knowledge had any contact with any individual traveling from any high COVID-19 risk countries (as deemed by UKFCO) in the 10 days prior to the shoot.
- You have not had a cough, a temperature of 37.8 degrees centigrade or above, a loss or change to sense of smell or taste in the last 10 days.
- ■If you develop any of the above symptoms at any point before or during or within 10 days following the shoot you will immediately inform the company engaging you and you will alert The Brighton Studio hello@thebrightonstudio.com
- COVID-19 testing as a further measure to mitigate risk on site may be required. If so, you consent to a test.
- ■You will notify us immediately should anything change as regards to the above confirmations.
- For the purposes of GDPR you consent to our sharing and retaining your data to the extent that it is reasonably necessary for the safety of you and everybody on the production.

## Prevent the spread of COVID-19

As a private premises and in accordance with trade body guidelines, our C-19 safety policy remains as follows:

## **Visiting The Brighton Studio**

- 1. Have a negative result from a lateral flow test within 12 hours of your visit.
- 2. Appointment only visits. If you require a recce of the space in advance of your booking with us, please book in a time to visit. Unscheduled viewings are not permitted at this time.
- 3. Minimise the number of attendees wherever possible to maximise social distancing.
- 4. Let us know who's coming before you get here. The full name and contact details for all attending personnel must be provided by email in advance of the hire.
- 5. Sanitise your hands each and every time you enter the premises.

# Physical distancing

- 1. Capacities in all spaces are reduced at this time to assist with social distancing.
- 2. Maintain an advised social distance of 2m and a minimum of 1m social distance.
- 3. Where you cannot socially distance due to role, consider wearng a face covering.

#### **Sanitation**

- 1. Wash your hands with soap and water and use hand sanitiser for at least 20 seconds as often as possible.
- 2. Safely dispose of waste and keep surfaces clean wipe with antibacterial spray after use.
- 3. Please avoid paper distribution wherever possible. Throw rubbish and waste away as soon as possible.
- 4. Avoid touching your face before sanitising your hands.
- 5. When coughing or sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow.
- 6. Do not share hand tools or personal property such as phones, pens, drinking cups etc.
- 7. Open windows to encourage airflow wherever you can.
- 8. Encourage all members of your team to go outside for fresh air breaks.
